## GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATION, APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS

1. **Student must be:**

- Recommended by a Greater Portland Board of REALTORS® Member
- Either a graduating Senior of a Cumberland County High School  
or a current post secondary student, also a graduate of a Cumberland County High School  
OR a family member or acquaintance of a Greater Portland Board of REALTORS® member  
(REALTOR®/ Affiliate).
- Enrolled in a 2-4 year, full time, post secondary degree program

2. **Request for assistance must be received no later than April 16, 2010:**

- Needs based on family income and number of children living at home and/or in school

3. **Application will consist of: \*\***

- a. A nomination from a member of the Greater Portland Board (REALTOR®/Affiliate).
- b. A letter of introduction from student reflecting financial need, scholarship, citizenship, educational background, community involvement and in what degree program student is enrolled. The letter should cover in detail, the family status, how many children at home, currently enrolled in school (secondary and post secondary).
- c. A letter from either the student's Guidance Counselor, Principal or Teacher explaining why this particular student should receive the award; has the student been awarded any other scholarships and a copy of the student's transcript.

4. **At least one scholarship will be awarded annually:**

- Payment will be sent directly to the school in which the student is enrolled during the second semester after grades from the first semester, along with proof of enrollment for second semester have been received from the student. Upon request, the student can receive the scholarship payment directly, along with proof of enrollment for the second semester.

5. **Selection by Scholarship Selection Committee based on:**

50% Need  
25% Scholarship  
25% Citizenship
